FLIGHTMAP 8.7 Release


FLIGHTMAP 8.7 is the next minor release of FLIGHTMAP. It comes with new project data pages, a customizable menu, improved preset management and others.

Feature

Description

New project data pages

The project data pages have been rebuild for better performance and data entry. By default, the page opens now in read-only mode to quickly validate project data. Before editing the project data, the switch at the top of the page must be activated. This also prevents from accidently editing data.






Figure: new switch on project data page to edit project; left shows the de-activated switch for read-only and right-side activated to edit data.

Waterfall chart available in reporting

The portfolio waterfall chart is being used more and more by organizations in their portfolio planning to understand how a running total over the years (or quarters, or months) is build up. This is clarified by showing how the initial value is affected by a series of positive and negative values.

Due the increasing use of this chart, it is now also available to be added to reports for easy distribution or standardized periodically reporting. Same as for other charts, it can be added to a report via the \circ -icon at the top-right of a chart.




Figure: waterfall chart available in (automated) reporting.

Customizable menu

By default, the Flightmap menu is structured to reflect the portfolio model; for example portfolio, project, and market. With this new version of Flightmap, the menu can follow the organization's workflow, for example: 'Data entry', 'Portfolio analysis', 'Strategy building', and 'Decision making'.

In the customized menu, the already available pages can be added to a preferred menu, complemented with relevant pre-defined graphs.




Figure: custom menu structure to support organization's workflow

Improved preset management

Creating and editing presets has been improved to explicitly create a new preset or to overwrite the current preset.




Figure: new buttons to explicitly create a new preset or overwrite the current preset.

Other improvements

- The portfolio model has been improved which makes it easier to use sub-projects; the build-in logic for example automatically assigns sub-projects to the portfolio of the parent projects.
- Various performance improvements for charts and calculations
