

### FLIGHTMAP 9.1 Release

We are excited to announce the latest update to FLIGHTMAP. In this release, we have focused on enhancing the performance and usability of the software, as well as introducing new features that will streamline your portfolio management process. Below a breakdown of what's new.

**New List Views** Our list views, including Project, Composition, and Market lists, have undergone a complete overhaul with the latest available techniques. This results in much faster loading times, allowing you to work more efficiently. Loading and sorting your lists is now much faster – simply click on any column header to quickly organize your data. You can also customize your view by dragging and dropping column headers. Grouping the information in your lists can now be done by dragging items to the group bar, and instantly organize the information to suit your needs.




Figure: new list views (left) and new sensitivity analysis.

### New Sensitivity Analysis

Innovation portfolio management relies heavily on making informed decisions. To assist in this process, we've introduced a sensitivity analysis. Sensitivity analysis helps you understand the impact of different variables on your portfolio's performance, to answer question like 'How does an increase of 10% sales effects the NPV?'.

### Performance Improvements

We understand the importance of speed and efficiency in portfolio management. To boost performance, we made three major improvements:

- As presented above, the lists have been renewed. This makes it also possible to pre-generate the lists, to be activated when saving it as a preset. When pre-generated, the list is shown instantly on your screen.
- It is now possible to simultaneous load multiple panels, ensuring that your dashboard load quicker.
- Building upon the last release's faster project data pages, we have extended this speed enhancement to portfolio and market data, ensuring you can access information swiftly.

### Adjust Colours

Consistency is key in portfolio management. FLIGHTMAP recognizes items that are linked to each other and to give them the same colour for more intuitive overviews. With this release it has become possible to edit all these colour palettes. Users with an Administrator role can edit the colours within FLIGHTMAP (Administration > System settings), such as project classifications, stages, or project locations. This customization enables you to align the software with your organization's branding and visual standards.

### Individual Change Overviews

Transparency is key in portfolio management. To facilitate this, we've redeveloped the change overview for projects, portfolios, and markets. This improved feature makes it simpler to trace changes, letting you know who made a specific alteration and when it was made.

### Improved change tracking

In addition to the individual change overviews above, the lists have now new columns available to track the latest change and upload per project, portfolio or market:

- Creation date
- Last update
- Last upload
